THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF VARIOUS ROADS IN STEVENAGE DURING 'STEVENAGE OLD TOWN LIVE') ORDER 2022

NOTICE is given that Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from using the following lengths of roads:-

1. that length of High Street, Stevenage from its northernmost junction with Letchmore Road north westwards to its junction with A602 James Way, a distance of approximately 527 metres.

An alternative route will be via Letchmore Road, Sish Lane, Trinity Road, A602 (Lytton Way/High Street/James Way)

or via A602 (James Way/Lytton Way), Trinity Road and High Street.

2. that length of Drapers Way, Stevenage from its junction with High Street south westwards to its junction with Primett Road, a distance of approximately 72 metres.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles whilst the event takes place. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the event.

3. that length of Bell Lane, Stevenage from its junction with High Street south westwards for its entire length.

There is no alternative route available for vehicles whilst the event takes place. However vehicular access to properties in this road will be maintained whenever possible throughout the duration of the event.

4. that length of Letchmore Road, Stevenage from its junction with High Street south eastwards for a distance of approximately 70 metres.

The sections of roads will be closed between the hours of 2.00am on Saturday 6 August 2022 and 2.00am on Sunday 7 August 2022, when signs are in place.

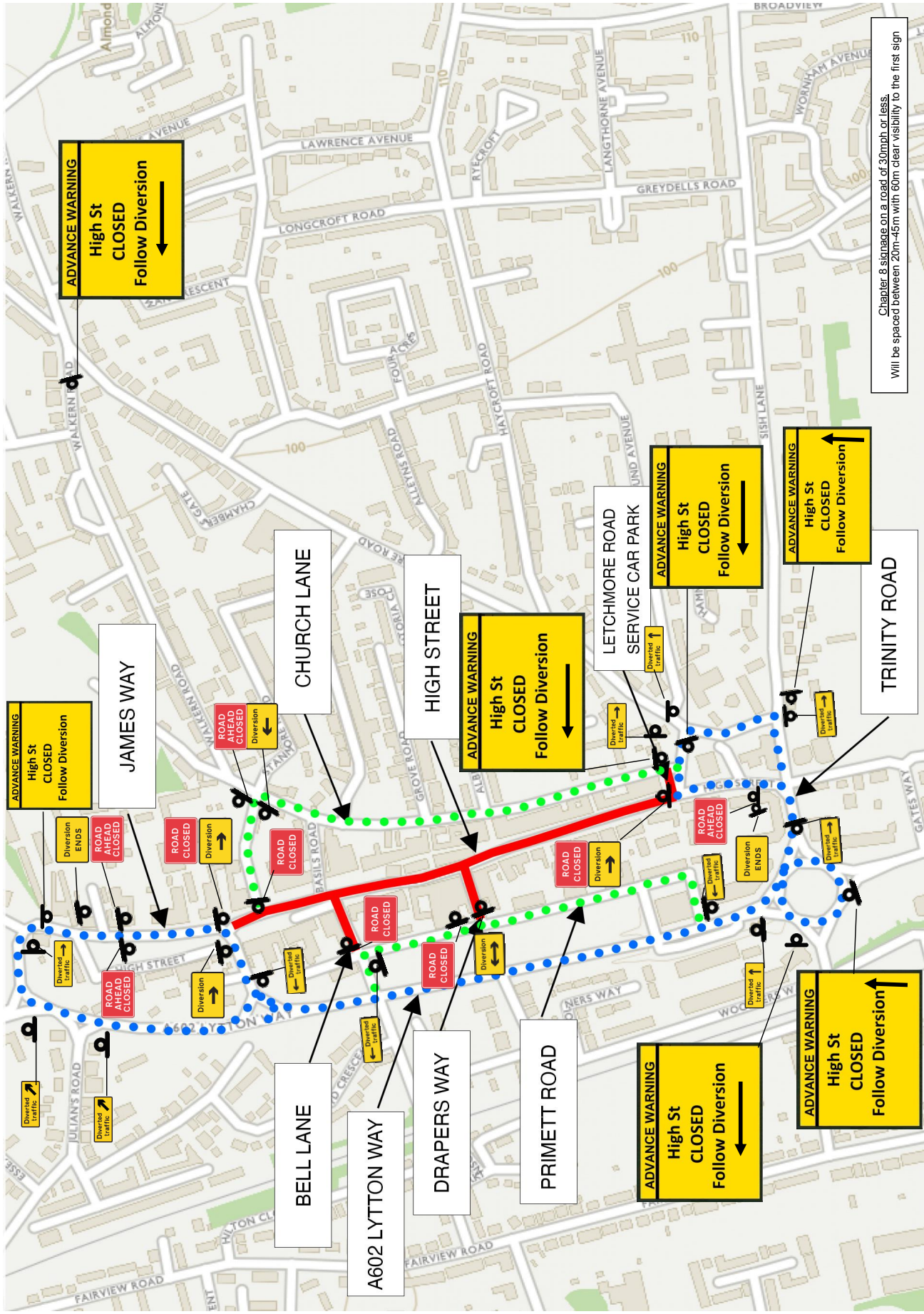
